CHANGING THE FACE OF CHRISTIAN FAMILY LIVING IN LEOGANE, HAITI

Each Christian Family Community is designed with a central building, a Christian Family Center, to serve as a church and social center for the residents of the community. Surrounding this center are individual family homes that provide private two-room family living quarters constructed in close proximity to one another in order to provide a sense of community for families previous isolated by distance on the mountain.

The building design is simple and economical to construct of simple, inexpensive materials that are easily transported up the mountain where there is a path only able to be traversed on foot or by horseback.

The community layout also lends itself to economy and safety in numerous aspects of the residents lives – a central water source eliminates the need for individual water collection cisterns, close proximity allows families to share fires for cooking, thus saving money spent for cooking charcoal, and the ability to readily assist one another in times of need such as during births, following injuries, etc. can contribute to higher survival rates.

We invite you to share in the blessings of this project to restore the most basic dignity of shelter to 92 families of our brothers and sisters in Haiti through your prayers, financial support and donations of materials.

Established in 2006, we support Bethesda Ministry, a multi-faceted Christian ministry in Leogane, Haiti. In addition to a main church with a congregation of approximately 200 believers, founder Pastor Abraham Joseph has planted 20 small “preaching stations” in the mountainous areas of Leogane. Our partnership with Bethesda Ministry offers us many opportunities to actively participate in the shepherding of and provision for our Christian brothers and sisters in this severely impoverished area.

In fall 2008, deadly hurricanes ravaged Haiti leaving in their wakes death and devastation from which most who were adversely affected by it have still not recovered. Specifically, ninety-two (92) families of Bethesda Ministry's mountain congregations lost everything to the hurricanes including their modest little homes.
